

Sec. 14-49. - Removal of feces from public and private places.

- (a) *Responsibility of owner.* No person owning, harboring, keeping or in charge of any pet shall cause, suffer or allow such pet to defecate on any common thoroughfare, street, road, curblineline, sidewalk, passageway, bypath, play area, park, schoolground or upon any space where the public congregate or walk on or upon any public property or place whatsoever or upon any private property without the permission of the owner of the property, unless the person immediately removes all feces deposited by the pet and disposes of the feces by any sanitary method approved by the health official.
- (b) *Enforcement.* This section shall be enforced by the police department, animal control officers and health official.
- (c) *Exemption.* This section shall not apply to people who use disability assistance animals.
