
Sec. 94-83. Gutters, streets and sidewalks.

- (a) No person shall sweep into or deposit in any gutter, street, parking lot, catchbasin or other public places the accumulation of any litter from any building or lot or from any public or private sidewalk or driveway. Persons owning or occupying property shall keep the sidewalk in front of the property free of litter. This section shall not apply to those periods of time fixed by the township for the collection of litter.
- (b) The owner or occupant of any property, or any employee or contractor of such owner or occupant, engaged to provide lawn care or landscaping services, shall not sweep, rake, blow or otherwise place leaves in or at the edge of the street. If such items are placed in the street, or at the edge of the street, the party responsible for placement, the owner and/or the occupant of the property must remove same from the street or edge of the street, as the case may be, or said party shall be deemed in violation of this section.
- (c) Notwithstanding the prohibitions in subsection 94-83(b), sweeping, raking, blowing or otherwise placing leaves at the curb or along the edge of the street is allowed during the seven days prior to a scheduled and announced collection, and shall not be placed closer than ten feet from any storm drain inlets. Placement of any leaves at the curb or along the edge of the street at any other time or in any other manner is a violation of this section. If such placement of leaves occurs, the party responsible for placement, the owner and/or occupant of the property must remove the leaves from the curb or along the edge of the street or said party shall be deemed in violation of this section.
