

Certified Food Protection Manager Training

New Jersey Food Code Regulations require that at least one person in charge of a Risk Type 3 establishments shall be a Certified Food Protection Manager. Risk Type 3 establishments are full service restaurants with complex advanced preparation of raw foods and the re-heating of 3 or more food items. In New Jersey, a Certified Food Protection Manager Certification is obtained by successfully passing an exam issued by an organization approved by the Conference for Food Protection.
