

# SNOW REMOVAL TIPS

**Think and plan ahead.** When snow is in the forecast, get all cars and other vehicles completely off the street. Park them so that the first one that has to get out is the last one parked in the driveway. Doing this will also give you less snow to shovel.

**When shoveling snow, always pile the snow behind the curb.** Never throw snow in the street because this only assures that the plow will plow it back in. If someone is hired to remove your snow, suggest to them that they do it this way.

**Always pile snow on the right side of your driveway when you stand with your back to your residence.**

Unfortunately, the plowing crew cannot lift up plows at every driveway. *If snow is piled on the left, it will likely be plowed back into the driveway when the snow-plow goes by.*



When you're standing with your back to your house, pile snow on the **RIGHT** side of the driveway!

**If you have a basketball hoop facing the street, please pull it back** so that the plows do not hit it while plowing. This is very dangerous for plow drivers, especially in the dark.

**Any owner or occupant of a home in a residential zone must have their sidewalk cleared within 12 hours of the first daybreak after snow has stopped falling.**

**Finally, take it easy.** *Shoveling is hard work – take a break when you get tired.*
