SOUTH BRUNSWICK CELEBRATES COMPLETION OF NEW TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT FINNEGANS LANE AND KORY DRIVE, ENHANCING SAFETY AND TRAFFIC FLOW

SOUTH BRUNSWICK, NJ (JULY15). The Township of South Brunswick today announced the successful completion and activation of a new, long-awaited traffic signal at the intersection of Finnegans Lane with Kory Drive. The project is a significant infrastructure upgrade aimed at improving motorist safety, managing traffic flow, and reducing congestion at the busy crossroads.

The installation of the signal addresses concerns from residents and findings of the Middlesex County Office of the County Engineer regarding increased vehicle volume on Finnegans Lane, a key artery connecting US Route 1 and NJ Route 27. The new signal is equipped with modern features, including vehicle detection, pedestrian countdown timers, and highly visible LED lighting to ensure the safe and efficient movement of all traffic.

"The safety of our residents is our absolute highest priority," said South Brunswick Mayor Charlie Carley. "This intersection has been a point of concern for many in our community, and I am proud that our administration, working under the leadership of Middlesex County government and with North Brunswick Township, has delivered a solution. This new signal is a direct investment in the well-being of everyone who travels through this area, from commuters heading to work to families in the surrounding neighborhoods."

The project was a key priority for Middlesex County government and the respective Township administrations. It involved planning, engineering studies, and coordination to minimize disruption during construction.
