## **SOUTH BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP RELEASES 2024 WATER QUALITY REPORT, HIGHLIGHTS EXCEPTIONAL STANDARDS**

SOUTH BRUNSWICK, NJ (JULY 21). The Township of South Brunswick is proud to announce the release of its annual Consumer Confidence Report (CCR), summarizing water quality data from the 2024 calendar year. The report confirms that all drinking water delivered to residents in 2024 met or exceeded state and federal health standards, reinforcing the Township’s long-standing commitment to providing safe, clean, and reliable water to its community.

“The results of the 2024 report are incredibly encouraging,” said Brian Fusco, Water Division Supervisor. “Our team’s dedication to maintaining and improving our water infrastructure means South Brunswick residents can continue to rely on the highest quality drinking water. This positive outcome reflects the sustained efforts in testing, treatment, and system enhancements. A special thank you to the Mayor and Township Council for funding these ongoing infrastructure upgrades.”

Key highlights from the 2024 report include:

- **Zero violations:** No contaminants were detected above maximum allowable levels.
- **Extensive monitoring:** Over 50 regulated parameters tested regularly throughout the year.
- **Transparent reporting:** The full CCR is available online for public review, ensuring transparency and accountability.

Supervisor Fusco added, “Transparency is vital. We encourage residents to review the report in full, understand the data, and reach out to us with any questions. Our goal is to keep the water flowing and the community informed.”
